Exhibitor Registration

Those wishing to attend ASC's technical sessions and social events must indicate Full Conference on the Exhibit Application & Contract Agreement (registration fees will be made available on the ASC 2010 web site at the beginning of April). Companies will be invoiced for these additional Full Conference registration fees.

Any "Exhibit Only" personnel must register for the \$95 rate on the Exhibit Application & Contract Agreement. This rate includes admittance **only** to the Welcome Reception, Exhibitor Reception, and Refreshment Breaks. It does not include access to the technical sessions, banquet event or the issue of the IEEE Transactions of Applied Superconductivity.

Cancellation

If written notice of cancellation is received by May 14, 2010, an administrative fee of 20% of the total booth fee will be retained. Cancellations after May 14, 2010 will result in forfeiture of the exhibit fee.

Special Requests

Helium, Nitrogen, Oxygen and Nitrous oxide tanks are allowed on the event floor with prior approval by the Fire Marshal. Tanks must be properly labeled for contents and firmly secured in the upright position, with valves protected against damage. Nitrous oxide and Oxygen tanks over 250 cubic feet are prohibited. Oxidizing gases (Oxygen or Nitrous oxide) in amounts in excess of 503 cubic feet may only be used in public assembly areas under permit for Hazardous Materials.

All special requests should be directed to the Omni Shoreham Hotel **PRIOR** to submitting the Exhibit Application & Contract Agreement and full payment. Special requests could be, but are not limited to, needs for cooling water and drains, electrical requirements to accommodate the use of a compressor, chemical mixtures and liquid hydrogen. If your request can be accommodated and is approved, you will receive confirmation from Freeman Expositions, Inc. by email. Please complete the Special Needs section on the Exhibit Application & Contract Agreement and attach the confirmation received from Freeman Expositions, Inc.

Assignment of Booth Space

Application & Contract Agreements are date-stamped upon receipt and exhibit space will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis until sold out. All payments must be received in full by May 14, 2010. Partial payments **will not** be accepted. Exhibit Application & Contract Agreements **will not** be processed without full payment. Cancellations prior to May 14, 2010 will result in an administrative fee of 20% of the total booth fee. Cancellations after May 14, 2010 will result in full forfeiture of the exhibit fee.

Booth assignments will be made by the Exhibit Chairman by May 28, 2010. To select your preferred booth area, please refer to the tentative exhibit floor plan included in the prospectus. Exhibitors wishing to avoid assignment of space adjacent to, or across from, particular companies should indicate so on the Exhibit Application & Contract Agreement.
