Review Facts and Figures

Here are some statistics for the >850 papers published in the *IEEE Transactions on Applied Superconductivity (IEEE-TAS)* volume 21.

- 2,621 invitations to referee were issued
- 1,937 opinions were returned (74%)
- 1,019 referees provided opinions
- 177 referees declined all invitations (a total of 276 declined invitations)
- Approximately 2.3 reviews per paper were received.
- Approximately 3.1 reviews per paper were solicited.
- Most reviews were completed in 14 days or less (14 days was the deadline). See Table 1.
- About half of reviewers completed only 1 review. See Table 2.

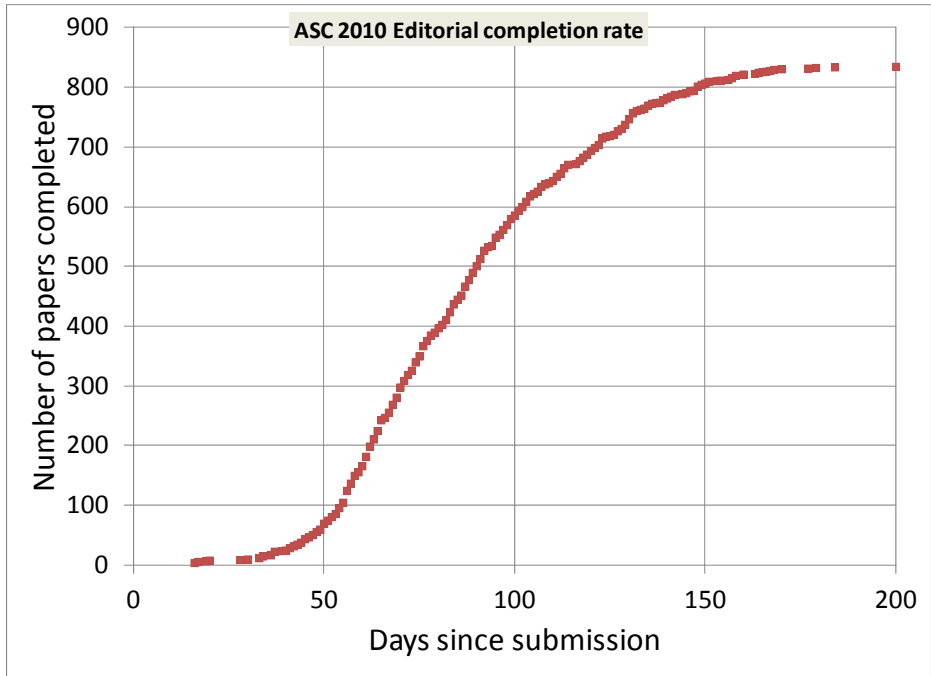


Figure 1. Paper completion rate for ASC 2010.

- Acceptance of papers began as soon as 40 days after submission. Acceptance extended to 120 days, with half of papers being accepted by about 90 days. See Figure 1.

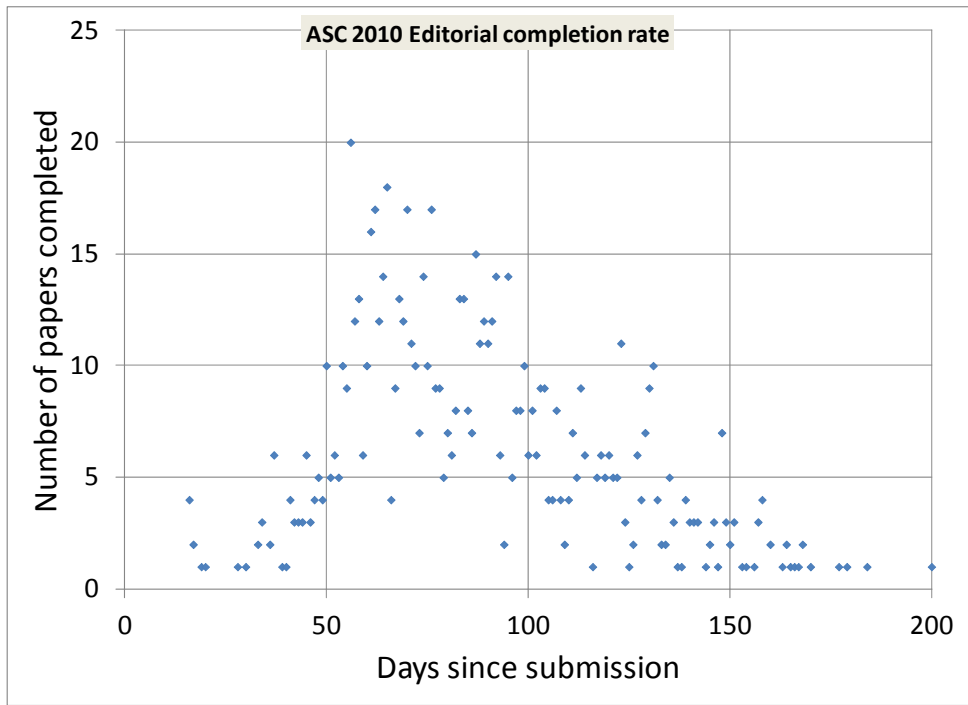


Figure 2. Acceptance of papers per day for ASC 2010.

- Accepted papers accumulated fastest around 60 days from submission. See Figure 2.
